Weston plans \$2 project to resurf two major roads

Weston has two big resurfacing projects planned for the early part of this year.

Work begins Monday on a 3-mile stretch of Royal Palm Boulevard, from Weston to Saddle Club roads. Weston Road's resurfacing will be along a 3.5-mile stretch, from north of

dle Club Road.

In addition, a sidewalk will be constructed on Royal Palm Boulevard between Weston Road and Bonaventure Boulevard. The total project cost is more than \$2.8 million.

Griffin Road to near Sad-

Jeff Maxwell, traffic engineer, said much of the two roads were resurfaced about 10 years ago, but some segments haven't been redone in a

much longer period.

"Roadway resurfacing is a time-proven method of extending the life of pavement structures that are still in serviceable condition," Maxwell said. "There are numerous advantages to resurfacing projects, including the long service life and relatively low life-cycle cost."

Maxwell said residents can expect intermittent lane closures, but no total road shutdowns.
